

Jacob Remin *Server Songs*. A multichannel sound installation, a generative choir of synthetic voices. Songs from the depths of the servers, songs about life lived on and through the internet. Location: Black Room

Hans Rosenström *A House Divided*. A sound installation that explores the mechanisms of words and their delivery. Location: Research Platform

Alona Rodeh *Runway Freefall*. A new CGI video work contemplating the topic of nocturnal deserted city-scapes. The clip depicts an imaginary location and event inspired by Malmö's northern industrial harbor. Location: Dressing Room




